

MOVING TOWARDS MUSIC LEADERSHIP 2021



This is an intensive 4-day virtual training course for teachers, teacher trainees, teaching assistants and community musicians who work in primary schools. Applicants would be expected to have some musical skill and demonstrate an interest in becoming a music subject leader or undertaking a refresh of the role.

The four seminars will be delivered as a series of videos and webinars, timetabled for Saturdays, to avoid clashes with work commitments:

A place on this programme will incur a £195 fee, to include all materials. Certificates are awarded on completion of the module.
