Hackney Youth Music Forum

- Set up in January 2014 to enable YP to influence music provision across the borough
- Founding members come from across:
 - Secondary schools Yr8 upwards
 - Instrumental ensembles
 - Choirs
 - Bands
 - Partner organisations







- Monthly sessions became twice monthly sessions
- Lots of team building games/activities
- Visiting guests e.g.:
 - Emeli Sande's drummer (former Hackney student)
 - GSMD new PACE degree opportunities
- Discussions about music making:
 - Who's music is it?
 - What is HYMF and who is it for?
 - Who will lead it?







- Not just about those in the room
- April 2014 HYMF did a survey across the borough & invited Sound Connections to support their survey
- HYMF analysed results themselves which led to running their own projects including a sell-out show at Chats Palace
- Other supported events include:
 - MyHackney Festival
 - Live Streamed music events
 - Curating the Live Stage at the Hackney One Carnival each year







So what about school music?

- Does classroom time need to be spent learning about musical facts and knowledge? Should be about music making and understanding
- Not enough music lessons in secondary schools as compared to maths, English and science
- Schools should not treat music as less important than other subjects e.g. extra curricular

- Should not always be about 'creative' vs. 'academic'
- Music is hard work!











- Need to find a balance between performing and writing
- Need exposure to a broad and diverse range of music:
 - Pop music
 - Trap
 - Classical
 - Vocal
 - Jazz and more
