We are seeking to appoint a dynamic and passionate Assistant Principal. The successful candidate will play a pivotal role in the organisation's leadership and management, ensuring the delivery of high-quality music education and creating performance opportunities across Kirklees. As the Assistant Principal, you will work closely with the Principal as part of the Senior Leadership Team (SLT) and alongside a dedicated group of music teachers to inspire a love of music and develop musical excellence among students of all ages and abilities.

This full-time post is based on 42 weeks per annum (39 of which fall within the school year) and includes national Teachers Pension Scheme membership.

The salary for this post is £47,000 per annum. The role includes a teaching commitment of 2 days per week and three 3 days of management time per week during the school term.

A full driving licence and access to transport are desirable for this role. However, if an applicant does not hold a driving licence due to a disability but is otherwise suitable for the role, Musica Kirklees is committed to making reasonable adjustments to the timetable, and your application will still be considered.
