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So what is it all about this term?

This term we will be celebrating diversity in Surrey and beyond through food and music. During each session we will explore music from a particular continent and we invite parents, carers and staff to bring food that links to that continent to share during the session. For example, for Europe you might bring Scottish shortbread or tapas and for Asia and the Middle East samosas or hummus. The sharing of food will be a lovely way for everyone to connect beyond language and provides an energetic springboard for us to start the music activities!

Some practicals: Please bring pre-cooked/cold food only. Please label food to indicate if vegetarian or vegan. If food contains meat please label appropriately including if it is Halal. We will presume that all food may contain dairy, nut extract and gluten unless indicated.

We can reimburse low income families for any ingredients bought up to £10 per session (please provide receipts).

Session timings:

10am - Music Session 1 for SEN children who would benefit from additional support

11am - All members arrive for welcome and food sharing

11.30am - Music session 2 for all members

What is the Orchestra of Unlimited Potential (UP!) and who is it for? UP! is an Inclusive Orchestra for young people of all backgrounds, musical interests and abilities in Surrey aged 12 to 19 (learning disabled 25, in care up to 21). It is suitable for experienced musicians as well as complete beginners and young people with special educational needs and physical disabilities. We are particularly interested in welcoming young people who have been unable to access music education because of their life circumstances and lack of suitable opportunities on offer locally. Whilst there are no specific entry requirements and no audition process we do not think it is suitable for young people who are unaware of their surroundings or unable to engage with the music making process. Please do contact us to discuss this if you are unsure.

What happens at UP! Sessions? The Orchestra is led by an awesome team of professional musicians whose aim is to ensure each participant has a meaningful musical experience regardless of ability, musical interest, vocal style or instrument. The team is experienced in supporting young people in mainstream settings as well as those who have mental health, disability, behavioural, ESL (English as a second language) needs and young people from diverse cultural and religious backgrounds. Music made at the rehearsals is created by the participants under the guidance of a musical director and the music support team on the ground.
