Thank you to school colleagues who have agreed to provide a device in school for students to be able to continue receiving their individual music lessons 'remotely', we are doing our very best to accommodate all of our students and it is hugely appreciated how schools are also going more than the extra mile to help facilitate students' musical learning. We will be in touch in due course with details on how and when these lessons will be delivered.

Following government guidance, we will not be delivering weekly tuition on brass, wind and vocal lessons in school settings and we will be looking to support these on our virtual learning platform.

Where our teachers are able to visit one school per day and are not shielding, we will be able deliver instrumental tuition on handheld instruments such as strings and percussion.

The key risk assessment points are:

1. No singing/brass/woodwind lessons in school
2. Normal social distancing required/hand hygiene/etc...
3. Large enough space in the practice room to allow for this safely
4. Appropriate ventilation available in the teaching room
5. One in and One out system for the students
6. No sharing of instruments or equipment
7. Students to fill in planners with their own pen/pencil or a follow up email to parents
8. No Breathing / Singing demonstration exercises
9. 1 school per day per teacher
10. Teacher to follow internal school risk assessment for teaching outside of a bubble.
