



Which Copy Counts?

PMLL offers the Schools Printed Music Licence and the Music Services Licence. A condition of both these licences is that information is submitted on music is copied and arranged to help ensure correct royalties are paid to creators via the publishers.

Below is a table which shows the different activities, and which licence they should be reported under.

Where do I report the data?		
Activity	Schools Printed Music Licence	Music Service Licence
Copying and arranging music as part of curriculum music lessons for pupils of the school	✓	X
Copying and arranging music as part of extra-curricular activities for pupils of the school	√	X
Copying and arranging music for whole class instrumental tuition for pupils of the school	✓	X
Copying and arranging music for individual instrumental lessons provided via the school for pupils of the school	✓	X
Activities carried out by music service teachers such as ensemble teaching on school premises for pupils from a range of schools (e.g. where the schools is used as a venue hire by the music service).	X	✓
Area activities carried out by music service staff such as individual, small group and ensemble teaching at music service or other premises.	X	✓

Reporting data

It is important that the correct information is submitted under the correct licence. Music Services reporting for the **MSL** can submit data via the PMLL portal which has a simple data submission form. We can also supply a spreadsheet for you to collate information on the works that have been copied if you are submitting data where works have been copied under the **SPML**.

We are working on updating the PMLL portal to allow Music Services to be able to submit data on behalf of a school and will be in touch when this is active.
